I am a Fuller student, how do I register for the course?

- Step 1: Standard registration.
 - Meet with your advisor.
 - The course is listed as a summer intensive. You can register for the course during the normal summer registration process that takes place in the Spring quarter.

I am a student at a cross-enrollment institution (Haggard School of Theology, Claremont School of Theology, Denver Theological Seminary, Seattle University, and San Francisco Theological Seminary).

- Step 1: Standard registration.
 - Meet with your advisor at your institution.
 - The course is listed as a summer intensive at Fuller. You can register for the course during your normal summer registration process.

I am a *visiting* student, how do I register for the course?

- Step 1: Apply for admission for the School of Theology as a “visiting student”. The visiting student application requirements include:
 - Completed Application for Admission
 - An official Letter of Good Standing from primary institution stating the following:
 - a) Degree program in which currently enrolled
 - b) Statement of good standing
 - c) Statement that an official Bachelors transcript is on file
 - d) Statement that credit will be transferred
 - Religious Autobiography, parts A and B

- Step 2: Registration.
 - After being accepted, contact your academic advisor.
 - The course is listed as a summer intensive at Fuller. You will register for the course during the summer registration process.

I am not currently a graduate student, but want to apply to begin my graduate studies at Fuller with these summer courses and take them for graduate credit.

- Step 1: Apply as a Limited Enrollment Student with the School of Theology. The application requirements include:
 - Completed Application for Admission
 - Official Bachelor’s transcript from an accredited institution showing a grade point average of 2.7 or above of all postsecondary schools attended, showing a bachelor's degree earned from an accredited institution of higher

learning, with a cumulative undergraduate grade point average of 2.7 or above.

- One pastoral reference form (form provided).
- Religious Autobiography, parts A and B.

- Completed Application for Admission
- Official Bachelor's transcript from an accredited institution showing a grade point average of 2.7 or above of all postsecondary schools attended, showing a bachelor's degree earned from an accredited institution of higher learning, with a cumulative undergraduate grade point average of 2.7 or above.
- One pastoral reference form (form provided).
- Religious Autobiography, parts A and B.

➤ Step 2: Registration.

- After being accepted, contact your academic advisor.
- The course is listed as a summer intensive at Fuller. You will register for the course during the summer registration process.

Only spouses of current Fuller students wishing to apply as audit-only students may be considered for admission without holding an accredited Bachelor's degree.)
